Art Enrichment Program with Ms. Autumn: We are fortunate to have Ms. Autumn as the team teacher in our 2-year-old program, as well as the Art Teacher for the 3-year-olds and Pre-K groups in the afternoon. Ms. Autumn uses Howard Gardner's "Multiple Intelligences Theory" focusing on various domains as children study one artist over a period of a month. The large emphasis is placed on creative exploration, which we know is essential for children this age.
